Minutes of the October 1, 2020 Virtual Meeting

The Norfolk Electoral Board was called to order at 10:07 a.m. by Mr. Ziegenfuss in a virtual meeting. The meeting was virtual due to the COVID-19 pandemic and the State of Emergency called by Governor Northam.

Approval of Minutes from the September 23, 2020 Electoral Board Meeting

Ms. Carrington moved to approve the minutes from the September 23, 2020 Electoral Board Meeting. Mr. Khandelwal seconded the motion. The Board unanimously approved the minutes from the meeting.

Approval of Officers of Election

Ms. Iles presented a list of fifty-six (56) potential Officers of Election for appointment. Mr. Khandelwal's motion to approve the list was seconded by Ms. Carrington. The Board unanimously voted to approve those on the list for a term ending February 28, 2021.

Discussion of November 3, 2020 General Election and Early Voting

Ms. Iles notified the Board regarding Chief and Assistant Chief Officers of Election training and invited Board members to attend.

Mr. Khandelwal and Ms. Carrington will be at the Elections Warehouse on October 5 at 9 a.m. to swear in the staff and begin L&A Testing for the voting equipment to be used in the satellite voting locations for early voting and on Election Day in the Precincts.

Mr. Khandelwal was a guest of the Ghent Business Association this morning, discussing early voting locations.

The Board welcomed Ms. Abrams and thanked her for both attending the meeting and being a new Officer of Election.

Mr. Khandelwal moved to adjourn the meeting, which was seconded by Ms. Carrington. The meeting was adjourned at 10:16 a.m. by unanimous vote of the Board.
